KSCSTE - VINVISH - CSIR-NIIST Joint Research Programme

Kerala State Council for Science, Technology and Environment (KSCSTE) has launched a new programme 'Partnering Academic Industrial Research (PAIR)' for establishing partnership in high quality collaborative research between R&D institutions, academia and industry. In this connection, Vinvish Technologies Pvt. Ltd, CSIR-NIIST and KSCSTE are partnering for a joint research programme in frontier area of Optoelectronics leading to Ph. D.

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for the KSCSTE - VINVISH - CSIR-NIIST joint research programme, as per the requirement given below:

- Name of the post : **Junior Research Fellow**
No. of position : **One**
Essential Qualification : **M. Tech (Optoelectronics) with minimum 55% or equivalent.**
(a relaxation of 5% marks will be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer)/ differently abled and other eligible categories
Desirable Qualification : UGC-NET/JRF OR UGC-CSIR NET/JRF OR GATE OR KSCSTE Research Fellowship OR other research fellowships of Central and State Government departments /agencies
Fellowship : **Rs. 30,000/-p.m. + 10% HRA for first two years and Rs. 35,000/-p.m. + 10% HRA for third year**
Age limit as on 01-07-2017: **30 years**
(a relaxation of maximum 2 years will be allowed for candidates with highly meritorious background)

The candidates will be selected based on the written test/interview, which will be held at KSCSTE. The candidate selected shall enroll for fulltime Ph.D at University of Kerala. After the submission of Ph.D. Thesis, the candidate will be appointed as an intern at the sponsoring industry with the possibility of subsequently being absorbed as permanent staff.
